## This year, perhaps more than most in recent memory, we've been reminded of the importance of home.



Peterson's work, which ranges from bespoke residential spaces to boutique resorts








and distinctive dining, has been widely acknowledged from Scottsdale to Beverly Hills. "What Erik [Peterson] offers is a tailored design approach that really prioritizes the needs and values of his clients," says Larsen. With such an immense passion for the area, Larsen and Peterson's conversation quickly turned from their own experiences to one of collaboration.
